Program Details:

States' 4-H Summer Outbound programs provide American 4-H youth with the opportunity to travel to foreign countries for a month-long cultural immersion experience. Delegates live with volunteer host families* and engage in experiential learning about a new way of life. Delegates experience aspects of daily life that allow . them to more deeply understand both their host culture and their own culture. Our network of like-minded international partners recruit host families and plan enrichment activities.

*Exception: Argentina uses group accommodations on program

- Adult chaperones accompany the group during international travel and remain in-country to provide support.

- No prior language study is required, but it certainly is helpful! Our international partners have English-speaking staff on hand to assist you in communication.

2022 OUTBOUND PROGRAMS



Program Fees Include:

Welcome packet; overnight national departure orientation; arrival orientation in host country; portion of chaperone fee; Accident & Sickness Medical Insurance; in-country transportation, lodging, and meals while on-program; country specific activities as determined by international partner organizations

Program Policies:

- Program Cancellations:
 - * Prior to March 31, 2022; \$100 cancellation fee, The
 - remaining amount of program deposits will be refunded.

 * After April 1, 2022: No refund of paid deposits, unless full program cancelled by States' 4-H
- · Airfare is non-refundable once issued
- In-State Fees may apply
- Unaccompanied Minor fees may apply (up to \$150 each way)
- . No donor checks are accepted by the States' 4-H Office. donors must send checks directly to the delegate

FAQs:

Q: Will a chaperone accompany the group?


A: Yes! Adult chaperones accompany the group during international travel and remain in-country to provide support

Q: Do I need to speak another language? A: No prior language study is required, but it is certainly helpful!

Our international partners have English-speaking staff on hand to assist you in communication.

Q: How will States' 4-H prepare me for my homestay?

A: States' 4-H provides travel handbooks that cover everything from packing lists to financial matters to cultural information. In addition, each state may conduct a spring orientation covering these topics. Delegates also receive details during the States' 4-H group conference call in late spring and a National Departure Orientation the day before the international flight.



What to do?

Montana 4-H is excited to make the switch to a NEW, more user friendly and updated, 4-H enrollment system. Beginning October 1, 2020 families can access their account and re-enroll using ZSUITE.

Below are the steps to find your family or household ZSuite account and enroll in 4-H for the new, 2020-2021 4-H year.

1.

Using your computer, smart phone or other device go to

www.4h.zsuite.org.

2.

Click SIGN UP.

Complete all of the fields. Use the FAMILY email address from 4honline as the ADULT EMAIL to connect your previous enrollment with ZSUITE.

If you are not sure what your "family email" is contact your MSU Extension office and they can tell you. Click **LET'S GO**.

3.

Arrive at your HOUSEHOLD DASHBOARD. Click on the name of the family member you want to reenroll, click on the blue "start enrollment" button and follow the steps.

4.

Complete/Update the personal information, waivers, club and projects and hit SUBMIT.

*Counties may have an additional payment step.
